IMPORTANT RACE RULES & REGULATIONS

START PROCEDURE:

Start line procedure is as follows. If you are caught starting on the wrong line, you can and will be penalized.

- Riders are to line up at the start based on skill level
 - o Line 1- Expert
 - Line 2-Amateur
 - o Line 3 Novice
 - o Line 4 beginner
- Race officials reserve the right to combine and/or separate rows at their discretion- please be aware and mindful when officials are making any changes.
- The starter will start each line in approximately 30 second intervals or when the track is clear.
- All starts are live engine
- Starter will utilize a green flag down when the flag is raised that indicates the start
- Riders, pit crew members, machines and equipment are not permitted on the starting line until authorized by the race official.
- All spectators must be off the start line and cleared by officials before the race can start.

RACE PROCEDURE:

Each race will be approximately 45 minutes. Checkered flag will come out to the leader as close to the 45-minute mark as possible. All riders must take the checkered flag to be considered finishers.

- 45occ/25occ pro and expert race can be up to 60 minutes
- track lengths are subject to change based on track layout and course conditions
- Riders may not change bikes during the race. You must finish on the bike you started on
- If you exit the track at any point, you must re enter the track in the same place
- All racers must have the appropriate SRA issued number on their bike. Members must have the same issued number on the front and both sides. Non-Members must have the SRA issued number on the front and left (clutch) side unless otherwise specified. If you do not have numbers on as directed, you risk not getting scored.
- It is the rider's responsibility to run the appropriate scoring transponder. If you do not have a transponder, you will risk not getting scored.
- If you are caught cutting the course, you will be disqualified
- If you change classes points earned will not carry forward

AGE REQUIREMENTS:

- You must be at least the age of the class you're racing to race it.
- Be prepared to show ID for all age categorized classes.

SKILL LEVELS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Pro, Expert, Amateur, Novice and Beginner
- These skill levels are racing at the same time on the track. Example- if you are a 30+ novice, PLEASE BE AWARE that there will be Pro's/Experts, Amateurs and Beginners on the track If you are in an agebased class. PLEASE BE AWARE that the age classes are combined with other ages please refer to the schedule.

TROPHIES ARE ISSUED AS FOLLOWS:

- MEMBERS-1 trophy is awarded for each 4 racers in class. For members, if there are less than 4
 - racers who finish, no trophies will be awarded.
- NON-MEMBERS-1 trophy is awarded for each 6 racers in class. For Nonmembers, if there are less than
 - 6 racers who finished, no trophies will be awarded.

TRANSFER RULES:

- SRA reserves the right to move you up or down skill level based on finish position.
- If you change a skill level, you will be required to continue at the level or higher. You will not be allowed to go back down a level
- Beginner will be required to transfer to Novice after winning 3 Beginner trophies
- A Novice will be required to transfer to Amateur after winning 4 Novice trophies
- An Amateur will be required to transfer to Expert after winning 5 Amateur trophies

RACING POINT SYSTEM:

- At all SRA races you will be awarded points according to your finishing position
- You must finish 50% of the leader's laps and take the checkered flag to earn your points
- You may consult the chart below to determine your points. At the end of the season earned numbers will be allocated to the point standing in your class. You can only accumulate points for the bikes class you are registered in as a member. You may register as a member in more than 1 class.
- Year End-You must finish 50% of the annual races to qualify for the year-end championship or class winner.
